\$36.99 Special Order ONLY	<p>Dutton-Goldfield Dutton Ranch Chardonnay</p> <p>A blend of five of their favorite vineyards in the coolest part of Russian River Valley. In addition to the usual core of lime and tangerine fruit that the old vines always offer, rich pear and ripe apple come more to the fore. Aromas of pear, citrus and butterscotch promise the richness of this wine, and the overtones of gardenia and sandalwood foretell its complexity. In the mouth, the typical solid structure of Dutton Ranch Chardonnay carries the unctuous citrus and candied pear fruit. It is this balance of bright acidity, fresh fruit, and lushness that make Chardonnay from Dutton Ranch so special.</p> <p><i>Great as an aperitif, try it also with your favorite fowl dishes, or any grilled fish.</i></p> <p>91 points, <i>Wine Spectator</i></p>

The mouth is striking for its combination of plush cherry and blackberry fruit, bright acidity and supple tannins, all carried through the persistent, spicy finish.</p> <p><i>A very versatile food match, try it with roasted fowl, salmon on the barbeque, chanterelle risotto, or your favorite fresh cheeses.</i></p> <p>90 points, <i>Wine Spectator</i></p>

Incredibly velvety. Complex and concentrated. The oak is mellow, elegant. Strong fruit character, with astonishing whortleberry notes. Expressive between 4 and 7 years, can age up to 15 years.</p> <p><i>A fine accompany to pork rib-roast with sage.</i></p>
\$44.99 Special Order ONLY	<p>Ehlers Estate One Twenty Over Eighty</p> <p>This Cabernet Sauvignon blend was created to express the broad diversity of our 23 individual vineyard blocks on our Estate vineyard. The name, One Twenty Over Eighty, is the "ideal" blood pressure and is a playful reminder of our unique ownership, dedicated to cardiovascular research. Aromas of cocoa, dark chocolate, high-tone red fruit, lavender, and French plums.</p>
\$40.99 Special Order ONLY	<p>Verget Chablis Vaillons</p> <p>In 1990, after 5 years as a wine broker, Jean-Marie Guffens founded his own négociant company, Verget. Pale, green-tinged color. Lively aromas of powdered stone, quinine, lime and mint. Bright, rich and spicy, with good grip and acidity leavening the impression of sweetness. Captivating flavors of apple and ginger. This tactile wine really dusts the palate with flavor on the back end.</p>

\$31.99	<p>Cuvelier Los Andes Coleccion</p> <p>"The portfolio begins with the 2006 Coleccion, composed of 60% Malbec, 20% Cabernet Sauvignon, 10% Merlot, and the balance Syrah and Petit Verdot. It was aged for 12 months in French oak. Purple-colored and nicely perfumed, on the palate it is spicy, elegant, and succulent. Already revealing elegance, it will continue to blossom with another two years in the cellar. Drink it now through 2016.</p> <p>Cuvelier Les Andes is owned by Bertrand and Jean-Guy Cuvelier, part owners of Chateau Leoville-Poyferre in Saint-Julien. The estate is located in the Uco Valley at the foothills of the Andes and encompasses 115 acres of young vines (age 5 in the 2006 vintage). The consulting winemaker is <u>Michel Rolland</u>*."</p> <p>90 Points – Robert Parker</p> <p><i>*Probably Renee's favorite winemaker and certainly one of the world's greatest.</i></p>
\$19.99	<p>Alberto Longo Cacc'e Mmitte di Lucera</p> <p>Deep ruby red color with violet highlights. Intense and persistent bouquet, reminiscent of wild berries. The palate is full-bodied and perfectly balanced with soft tannins.</p> <p>VARIETALS: Uve di Troia, Montepulciano and Bambino Bianco</p> <p>VINIFICATION: After a late October hand-picked harvest, alcoholic fermentation is carried out in temperature-controlled stainless steel tanks, allowing long contact of the must and with the skins. The malolactic fermentation follows into November. The wine is aged in stainless steel tanks for 3 months and finished in the bottle.</p> <p><i>Excellent with lamb and veal!</i></p>
\$25.99	<p>Borgo di Sugame Chianti Classico</p> <p>Borgo di Sugame Chianti Classico is made with Sangiovese grape plus a small percentage of Cabernet Sauvignon. It has a deep ruby color and on the nose a marked flowery and woody flavor. On the palette, it remains soft, well structured and full.</p> <p><i>Best accompanying red meat and hard cheese.</i></p>
\$41.99	<p>Domaine Chante Cigale Chateauneuf du Pape Rouge</p> <p>The estate is located in a very stony part of the Châteauneuf-du-Pape area, where you can find the famous "galets roulés" (rolled pebbles). A large part of the vineyard is on the famous plateau de Cabrières, near to Château Montredon.</p> <p>65% Grenache, 20% Syrah, 10% Mourvedre and 5% Cincault. The average age of the vines is 45 years. The vinification is traditional. Ageing in foudres (60%), new barrels (10%) and in cement tanks (30%) for a period of 14-18 months.</p> <p>This Chateauneuf du Pape has a dark ruby/plum color and a sweet black cherry and currant nose with notes of loamy soil intermixed with a hint of nori (the seaweed wrapper used in sushi restaurants), as well as pepper and lavender. It is very spicy, and that, of course, is a signature of the 2006s. Drink it over the next 7-8 years.</p>
\$22.99	<p>Hubert Veneau Pouilly Fumé</p> <p>A straight-up Sauvignon Blanc from this appellation east of Sancerre in the Loire Valley, has great intensity and structure, with strong notes of lemon and grapefruit, and a strangely sweet herbaceous backing. Dry and medium-bodied. There were some hints of peach towards the end. Unbelievable finish! The limestone soil in this region shows well. Pale yellow. A floral and fruity nose of grapefruit. Full on the palate with a hint of flintiness. Aged in stainless steel vats.</p> <p><i>Pairs with oysters or any other shellfish, many types of sushi, and tangy goat cheeses.</i></p>
\$25.99	<p>Ben Hogan Tribute Series Chardonnay</p> <p>Ben Hogan Chardonnay was hand-crafted using traditional "Burgundian" winemaking techniques. The bouquet is a complex array of tropical fruits beautifully integrated with spicy oak influences and the nuances associated with extended lees contact and stirring (known simply as batonnage). The palate reflects the fruit forward style of this wine while offering a number of layers that emerge as the wine breathes. The traditional winemaking develops greater length of flavor and complexity, all supported with refreshing natural acidity.</p>

\$41.99 SALE \$29.99*	Godspeed Cabernet Sauvignon This wine is from Mount Veeder, Napa Valley and 100% Estate Mountain Cabernet Sauvignon. Deep purple color with a big Mount Veeder nose suggesting truffle, vanilla, cedar, manzanita and blackberry. A luxuriously mouthfilling fruit with a good tannin grip and texturous palate feel. A voluptuous and well-structured wine that is attractive now and should easily age ten years. Only 550 cases were produced.
\$46.99	Opolo Rhapsody This classy estate Meritage is a masterful blend of Cabernet Franc, Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon and Petite Verdot. Wonderfully executed ripe cherry & currant laced fruits are shaded by spicy, toasted oak from aging on both French and American oak. Its exquisite balance and depth will keep you coming back for more.
\$31.99 SALE \$29.99*	Opolo Cabernet Sauvignon This huge and authoritative wine is dry and rich in tannins and shows a vast repository of flavors. Blackberry, black cherry, and new oak flavors are wrapped into a smooth, velvety mouth feel whose finish goes on forever. An Opolo classic since our first production, our 2006 Cabernet Sauvignon will not disappoint.
\$32.99	Lava Cap Granite Hill Reserve Petite Sirah This deeply colored wine has an intense nose of blackberries, blueberries, anise, and chocolate. It is rich and plummy in the mouth with raspberry and cherry fruit flavors. There are sweet French oak tones from the 18 months of barrel aging. Winemaker, Tom Jones, blended the 2006 Petite Sirah with 19% estate grown Zinfandel to add spice tones.
\$69.99	Jaure Winery Jj Jacinto Jaure Gran Reserva "The 2003 JJ Jacinto Jaure Gran Reserva is a blend of Malbec (40%), Cabernet Sauvignon (30%), and Syrah (30%). The fruit was sourced from a 53 year old vineyard and aged for 18 months in new French oak before being bottled unfiltered. Purple in color, it has a fragrant bouquet of pain grille, Asian spices, pencil lead, black cherry, blueberry, and black currant. Ripe and sweet on the palate, it has plenty of silky tannin well-concealed under a blanket of fruit. Nicely balanced and lengthy, it will evolve for 6-8 years and drink well through 2025." 92+ Points – Robert Parker
\$36.99	Sensi Testardo Sensi is a Super Tuscan from the Chianti region of Italy. The term "Super Tuscan" means that the wine is using French style grapes in addition to the more traditional ones. The Sensi is a blend of 30% Cabernet with 70% Sangiovese. The wine is aged for 12 months in oak, then another 24 in the bottle. It has rich berry flavors, with a smooth mouthfeel and long finish.
\$36.99	Graziano Coro Mendocino This unique blend of old vine Zinfandel and three classic Italian grape varieties, Sangiovese, Barbera & Dolcetto, have come together to create a wine that has great structure and elegance. Aromas of violet, spices, and cedar weave through the vibrant raspberry fruit character, culminating in a harmonious finish laced with vanilla and toasty oak. The wine's complexity and depth of flavor will continue to evolve with further bottle aging.

\$42.99 Special Order ONLY	<p>TR Elliott RRV Pinot Noir</p> <p>The color is a very pretty cherry red. The aroma is intense and deep. There are immediate red currant, violet and raspberry notes, blended with fig, vanilla and pepper. Hints of nutmeg, orange peel and allspice recede to black cherry and cola. The palate is bright and clean, with tastes of cherries, holiday spices, sweet vanilla and pepper. Three Plumes is an elegant wine with a silky and delicate texture, a medium body and a nice balance between tartness and richness. It finishes with layers of fruit and terroir.</p>
\$24.99 Special Order ONLY	<p>Halter Ranch Cotes de Paso (GSM blend)</p> <p>A Southern Rhone Valley-style blend of Grenache, Mourvedre, Syrah, Counoise and Cinsault (think Chateauneuf-du-Pape), our 2007 Côtes de Paso displays a dark ruby color and a concentrated, high-toned nose of blackberry, currant, black raspberry and ripe strawberry fruit, complemented by warm earth, sage, spice and roast coffee notes. The sumptuous palate offers dense blackberry and spicy blackcurrant flavors leading to a long, rich finish featuring round, ripe tannins and a savory roasted tone. Delicious now with grilled lamb and steak, rib roast, and hearty stews made with 'herbes de Provence', this luscious red will age well for another 4-6 years.</p>
\$29.99	<p>Armida Poizin</p> <p>This is definitely a crowd favorite. A fun package, lush and delicious wine, and affordable to boot! The nose is fruit driven with fresh plum, Bing cherry, and zinberry. The mouthfeel is soft, with a bit of milk chocolate, sweet oak, and a long vanilla finish. Enjoy this Poizin with caution, it is the wine to die for!</p>
\$39.99 Special Order ONLY	<p>Boekenhoutskloof "The Chocolate Block" Franschoek</p> <p>The 2008 Chocolate Block is a blend of Syrah (69%); Grenache noir (12%); Cabernet Sauvignon (10%); Cinsault (7%) and Viognier (2%). Finding it hard to fathom what such a blend might taste like? Imagine intense spicy notes supported by ripe plum, black fruit and violet aromas. The wine has a grippy acidity and well integrated tannins with a well textured and rounded mouth feel. The long, elegant and succulent finish with superb structure from the Cabernet Sauvignon leads us to believe that this wine has at least 8 years of aging potential.</p>
\$22.99 Special Order ONLY	<p>Eberle Sangiovese</p> <p>Eberle's limited production Sangiovese will please any Chianti fan. This medium bodied, moderate tannin wine exhibits hints of ripe cherry and cola on the nose supported by flavors of raspberry and hints of anise. A true salute, to Tuscany!</p> <p><i>Eberle's Sangiovese is a delight on its own, but its' refined characteristics shine when paired with an appetizer of fresh bruschetta, an entrée of risotto, a delicious Italian thin crust pizza with tomato sauce or even spaghetti Bolognese.</i></p>

<p>\$49.99 SALE \$44.99* Special Order ONLY</p>	<p>Gosset Champagne NV Gosset is small for a grand marque. At 50,000 cases a year total production they make about as much Champagne as Krug. They are located in Ay, the heart of Champagne, along with Bollinger, Deutz and De Meric, and they have been making wine there since 1584, the oldest currently operating wine producer in Champagne. None of their Champagnes ever go through malolactic. This is rich, layered Champagne with brioche and pear aromas and a long, bright finish from the suppressed malo. It is snappy enough to serve for toasting, but has enough guts for a salmon dinner and enough exotic intrigue to keep the interest of a Champagne enthusiast all night. It should keep well, and even improve for a couple of years if you like the taste of aged Champagne.</p>
<p>\$46.99 SALE \$39.99* Special Order ONLY</p>	<p>Faust "Illumination" Sauvignon Blanc Intrigued with white wines from the Loire Valley, and desirous of a white wine from Quintessa that he could enjoy at home with friends and family, Agustin planted a half-acre of Sauvignon Blanc at the Quintessa estate in 2002. "Bright citrus and lime zest aromas dance alongside herbs and an intriguing steely note on the nose. The first sip unveils nectarine and stone fruit with tangy pomelo and grapefruit flavors balancing the wine's ample body and complexity. A mouthwatering, lingering finish persists with citrus and mineral notes." Charles Thomas, winemaker</p>

Round and mouth-filling, with flavors of rich pear, apple, and honeysuckle filling the palate. Vibrant citrus, honey, and mineral notes highlight the long finish. Textural and elegant.</p>
<p>\$49.99 SALE \$44.99* Special Order ONLY</p>	<p>De Ponte Dundee Hills Estate Pinot Noir This is a pure nose of blackcurrant, raspberry with beautifully integrated violet, spices and tobacco flavors. It is a succulent wine with a really nice density and complexity, the velvety structure is well supported by refined tannins which give the wine an amazing length and complexity. "The 2007 Pinot Noir Dundee Hills was aged in 20% new oak for 12 months. Medium ruby-colored, it offers up a lovely perfume of cinnamon, allspice, rose petal, cherry, and raspberry. On the palate it displays medium body, an elegant personality, vibrant acidity to balance the savory flavors, and a lengthy finish. Drink it through 2017; it is the prototypical style shaped by the 2007 vintage. The De Ponte Cellars property was purchased in 1999 and the first vintage was 2001. There are currently 17 acres planted to an assortment of clones." 90 Points – Robert Parker <i>Food Pairings: Creamy penne pasta with pancetta, rigatoni with a duck ragout, grilled leg of lamb with rosemary roasted potatoes.</i></p>
<p>\$59.99 Special Order ONLY</p>	<p>Zaca Mesa Black Bear Block Syrah "This is always a great bottling, and Zaca Mesa's 2006 Black Bear Block goes to the head of the line in newly released California Syrahs. It's an enormously rich wine, filled to the brim with pure blackberries, currants, cocoa and peppery-spiced oak, and the finish turns to milk chocolate. But it's dry. The 2006 vintage was a very good one for Zaca Mesa's various Syrahs, and this is their best." 94 Points – Wine Enthusiast</p>
<p>\$49.99 SALE \$42.99* Special Order ONLY</p>	<p>Faust Cabernet Sauvignon Classic Napa Valley black and red fruit in the nose; also aromas of vanilla and cedar. Dense and rich on the palate with abundant, concentrated fruit and a rich, luxurious finish. In 2006, a cool, wet spring gave us a late start to the growing season. Summer was mostly cool with some heat spikes, ideal for Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon. Harvest came a little late following some warm and cool spells in August and September, and moderate weather during harvest allowed for fully ripe, intensely flavored fruit. At harvest, the grapes are double sorted and crushed at Quintessa, then cold macerated and fermented in oak and stainless steel tanks. Faust is aged for 18 months in 25% new and 75% once-used French oak.</p>

\$49.99 Special Order ONLY	Dosnon & Lepage Champagne Brut NV "Yellow-gold with a steady bead. Dried pear, citrus and smoky mineral aromas are complicated by floral, vanilla and blonde tobacco notes. Zesty, mineral-accented orange and pear flavors blend finesse with power, picking up a sweet honeysuckle quality with air. Finishes taut, long and vibrant, with the mineral note repeating. I love this style." 93 Points – International Wine Cellar
\$42.99 Special Order ONLY	Merry Edwards Russian River Sauvignon Blanc The experience of tasting this luscious Sauvignon Blanc begins with a complex, mouthwatering aroma of golden delicious and honey crisp apples accented with crème brûlée and sweet Meyer lemon. Sophisticated mineral notes appear as the wine opens. An underlayment of lychee fruit, ripe pineapple and white peach then follows. The rich palate is finely tuned, with an excellent, refreshing balance. If possible, allow some of this vintage to age in your cellar — patience will bring ample reward.
\$52.99 Special Order ONLY	Anne Amie Prismé Pinot Noir Blanc Prismé is the truest expression of the Pinot noir grape. They select only the finest blocks of Pinot noir and gently press the grapes, liberating the free run juice, but not the color or tannins from the skins. It is then barrel-fermented, and aged on its lees in French oak barrels for 18 months. This structured white wine has a backbone of acidity, a voluptuous mid-palate and a long, creamy finish. Prismé is named after the word prism- the splitting of white light into its corresponding colors. Here they are doing precisely that in reverse, making a rich, textured white wine from Pinot noir.
\$59.99 Special Order ONLY	Domaine de la Vougeraie "Reunion de Famille" Bourgogne The nose has good intensity, at first spicy, evolving towards notes of fresh leather, reinforced by a touch of mint. Palate: The mouth is fine, balanced, complete, at once concentrated and exquisite, with aromas of fresh red fruits such as redcurrants. The long finish with big tannins suggests good keeping potential. Food Pairing: Match it with fillet of duck with wild mushrooms.
\$79.99 SALE* \$74.99 Special Order ONLY	Casanova di Neri Brunello Montalcino "Blackberries and blueberries on the nose. Full-bodied, with silky and racy tannins, as well as a hint of vanilla. Long and pretty. Very clean. Needs a little time to open. Best after 2010." 91 Points - Wine Spectator "The 2004 Brunello di Montalcino is a big, fruit-driven wine. Made in a concentrated, opulent style, this Brunello offers tons of fruit and a round, soft personality. There isn't too much nuance in the wine today, but that should develop in bottle. The long, polished finish invites a second taste. For now, this remains one of the more overtly fruit-forward wines of the vintage. The entry-level Brunello spends roughly 40 months in large, neutral oak. Anticipated maturity: 2010-2019." 91 Points - Wine Advocate
\$154.99 SALE \$149.99* Special Order ONLY Limited Quantities	Bucella Cabernet Sauvignon "The blockbuster 2007 Cabernet Sauvignon is more primary, but it does display enormous fruit concentration, massive body, and wonderful purity, balance, and elegance. It is an extraordinarily promising 2007 with awesome fruit, depth and richness as well as a long finish. This offering will be even better with 5-7 years of bottle age, and should keep for 20+ years. Bucella, under the guidance of well-known winemaking consultant Celia Masyczek has fashioned brilliant Cabernet Sauvignons in both 2006 and 2007. The 2007s are slightly more powerful, backward wines (alcohol levels range from the upper 14% to low 15%), but they have enough structure as well as sensational concentration and depth to support the tannins." 91 Points – Robert Parker
